"Unless you detect, you don't know!" It's now about respond, detect, recover capabilities - prevent is now Business As Usual (BAU)!"

In this era of commoditised AI, CISOs are rethinking what it now means to be cyber resilient and then prioritise accordingly. Controls are necessary to have resilience. It's difficult to get the fundamentals right (noting that these 'fundamentals' are by no means 'basic') and we can't always enforce. How do we calculate our "minimum liability" and put controls in place that keep us alive when the worst happens. CISOs are assuming breach as we can't stop the front door. What controls can stop contagion and lateral spread at scale. Discussions will get right to the point in this candid and open sharing.

Considering the input we have received by partaking CISOs to date, topics are likely to include:

- Threat intelligence and proactive cybersecurity measures
- · De-risking and cyber risk quantification
- Al Policies and adoption
